RESOLUTION 12-05

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A DUST CONTROL POLICY FOR LITTLE FALLS TOWNSHIP

WHERE AS, said township's role and cost sharing for residents requesting dust control on the road on which they reside; and

WHERE AS, to make sure any and all costs associated with this request are fair and equitable to said township and residents whether they reside within the township or on a township line road;

WHERE AS, address funding issues for such application; and

WHERE AS, said townships discretion to make a dust control application on a given road be identified.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Little Falls Township sets forth the following policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Little Falls Township will seek two (2) cost quotes for dust control products and determine which one would be in the best interest of the said township and its residents, (not necessarily the low quote). Said Township will provide all prep work of site before application at no cost to the resident (s), as this is considered normal maintenance. The resident (s) share of the dust control product applied would be 50% regardless of where they reside in the said township. If water is needed because of dry conditions, the resident (s) share would be 100%; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the road that is to have a dust control product applied is a township line road, then the two (2) townships involved would each pay 25%, and the affected resident (s) share would remain at 50%. However, if the Township involved has a different policy, then this policy could be adjusted to satisfy both Township Boards; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, when a township road or section of township road has a request to have a dust control product applied, the Road Supervisor has the authority to order the work done prior to a Town Board meeting provided all the criteria in this policy has been met, and the residents have agreed to pay their share of the application cost. If another Township is involved, then the Road Supervisor would have to wait for their approval as well as Little Falls Township Board approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a contractor hired to perform said application of a dust control product cannot fulfill their obligation for some unforeseen reason, then the Road Supervisor has the authority to hire another contractor to fulfill the obligation in a timely manner at a price not to exceed 10% over the original quote; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funding for said application of a dust control product be approved at the first Township Board meeting after our annual spring road inspection, and that it be a "not to exceed"

amount that would cover dust control for an entire season. Once the “not to exceed “amount was used up more funding would have to be appropriated; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Little Falls Township reserves the right, at our discretion, to apply a dust control product on a given road because the road is a thoroughfare for many city, county, and township residents. The traffic count on a given road justifies applying a dust control product to preserve the integrity of said road or that the road is a public safety issue because of the amount of traffic; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisors of Little Falls Township are hereby authorized and directed to execute this policy on behalf of Little Falls Township.
